It would be very beneficial if folks will email me and let me know of any additions or changes to the list concerning deer damage that they experienced, so that the Garden Club can publish the compiled results. We expect to finalize the list by spring. If there are changes, I will send out updates several times before the list is published. If the deer ate in your garden any of the plants that I have listed, please let me know. Also, please let me know if you had plants that they did not eat in your garden. If you spray or fence, they do not count.

The following are plants that have only been reported as not been eaten by deer: Iris Yucca Juniper Rabbit Brush Native Asters Native Perky Sue Native Potentilla Barberry Shrub Russian Sage Cyprus Spurge – a euphorbia Globe Thistle - blue or white Centaurea – only Rosea, a pink thistle like flower & yellow hard head Lambs Ear Daffodil – narcissis Germander Yarrow Nepeta Purple Coneflower - echinacea White Bleeding Heart Soapwort Snow in Summer Jupiter's Beard Lemon Balm Thyme Lavender Mint Tarragon The following are plants that are not eaten by deer in a garden, but they are eaten, but not killed, by deer at another garden Oregano Salvia – Meadow Sage The following are plants that are not eaten by deer until late fall & not killed Garlic Chives
